Founded in 1988 by a group of Hope Town residents who were concerned about the unsustainable use of Abaco's natural resources; the organization developed out of their desire to help. Initially all-volunteer, FRIENDS has grown to a Staff of five and Board of ten that reaches communities across Abaco. Since the education program was formally established in 2006, FRIENDS has reached over 23,000 students through classroom presentations, field trips, after-school clubs, and summer camps. In 2015, the opening of the Frank Kenyon Centre for Research, Education, and Conservation helped build further connections between science and the community.

Our vision is that we are an island community that is living sustainably and proud to be stewards of its rich biodiversity.
